19/07/2009	<p>Pick up and transfer from Colombo to Pinnawala. Visit Pinnawala Elephant Orphanage.</p> <p>Pinnawala Elephant Orphanage- one of the popular attractions, established as a sanctuary covering 25 acres of lush forest by the Sri Lankan Government in 1975, is unique. Its purpose is to feed, nurse and house young elephants lost or abandoned by their mothers. Recently the sanctuary has also started a breeding program. Visitors are invited to observe and assist the baby elephants as they are fed from giant feeding bottles, before they plod down to the river for their daily bath. If you wish, take an elephant back ride (optional) and discover more about Asia's gentle giant.</p> <p>Proceed to Kandalama</p>	<p>Kandalama Hotel</p> <p>Deluxe Room</p> <p>Dinner + Breakfast</p>
20/07/2009	<p>After breakfast proceed to Sigiriya</p> <p>Sigiriya - King Kassappa (477-495 A.D) who shifted the Capital from Anuradhapura to Sigiriya made a fortress to surround his palace, which was constructed on the summit of a 500ft high rock, with necessary facilities. The Palace was surrounded by an outer-moat and wall and Inner - moat and wall pleasure garden, Mirror-wall, light colored and dark coloured damsel's frescoes, to cover the western wall and a beautiful staircase through the body of a Crouching Lion are some of the attractions here.</p> <p>Proceed to Kandy</p> <p>Kandy - the hill capital is another "World Heritage Site". It was the last stronghold of the Sinhalese Kings during the Portuguese, Dutch and British rule and finally ceded to the British in 1815 after an agreement.</p> <p>To the Buddhists of Sri Lanka and the World, Kandy is one of the most sacred sites as it is the home of the "Dalada Maligawa" - Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic of Lord Buddha.</p> <p>Temple of the Tooth Relic is the magnificent golden roofed temple, Dalada Maligawa Temple, which houses Sri Lanka's most important Buddhist relic - the sacred tooth of Buddha. The temple has a constant flow of worshippers and visitors in awe of the spectacular golden architecture and energetic Kandyan drummers ho signal the start and finish of the daily pujas</p> <p>In the evening witness a traditional Kandyan Cultural dancing show.</p>	<p>Amaya Hills Resort</p> <p>Standard Room</p> <p>Dinner & Breakfast</p>
21/07/2009	<p>After breakfast, proceed for Nuwara Eliya.</p> <p>Enroute visit Tea Plantation and a Tea Factory.</p> <p>Nuwara Eliya - The 'Little England' of Sri Lanka, is set against beautiful backdrops of Mountains, Valleys, Waterfalls and Tea Plantations. It is supposed to be one of the coolest places in the Island, but it is really just like an English spring day, although the temperature does drop at night.
