06/03/2009	<p>Leave fro Kandalama, En route visit Pinnawela Elephant Orphanage & Dambulla Cave temple.</p> <p>Pinnawela Elephant Orphanage- one of the popular attractions, established as a sanctuary covering 25 acres of lush forest by the Sri Lankan Government in 1975, is unique. Its purpose is to feed, nurse and house young elephants lost or abandoned by their mothers. Recently the sanctuary has also started a breeding program. Visitors are invited to observe and assist the baby elephants as they are fed from giant feeding bottles, before they plod down to the river for their daily bath. If you wish, take an elephant back ride (optional) and discover more about Asia's gentle giant.</p> <p>Dambulla - 92 miles from Colombo. Dambulla is famous for the five cave Temples on a rock. The first 03 caves are better, older and larger than the other two. Some caves dates to 1st C.B.C. All the 5 cave walls and ceilings are covered with Buddhist murals and there are more than 130 Buddha statues, statues of Gods and Kings are also found here.</p>	<p>Amaya lake Chalet Room Dinner + Breakfast</p>												
07/03/2009	<p>Leave fro Kandy, en route visit Sigiriya</p> <p>Sigiriya - King Kassappa (477-495 A.D) who shifted the Capital from Anuradhapura to Sigiriya made a fortress to surround his palace, which was constructed on the summit of a 500ft high rock, with necessary facilities. The Palace was surrounded by an outer-moat and wall and Inner - moat and wall pleasure garden, Mirror-wall, light colored and dark coloured damsel's frescoes, to cover the western wall and a beautiful staircase through the body of a Crouching Lion are some of the attractions here.</p> <p>Kandy - the hill capital is another "World Heritage Site". It was the last stronghold of the Sinhalese Kings during the Portuguese, Dutch and British rule and finally ceded to the British in 1815 after an agreement.</p> <p>To the Buddhists of Sri Lanka and the World, Kandy is one of the most sacred sites as it is the home of the "Dalada Maligawa" - Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic of Lord Buddha.</p> <p>Temple of the Tooth Relic is the magnificent golden roofed temple, Dalada Maligawa Temple, which houses Sri Lanka's most important Buddhist relic - the sacred tooth of Buddha. The temple has a constant flow of worshippers and visitors in awe of the spectacular golden architecture and energetic Kandyan drummers who signal the start and finish of the daily pujas</p> <p>Evening witness a traditional Kandyan cultural dancing show.</p>	<p>Amaya Hills Deluxe Room Dinner + Breakfast</p>
